Dear Mr. Moats:

I hope this letter finds you well. I attended the City Council meeting last night. The sitting council moved under *Gronberg v. Teton County Housing Authority*, 247 P.3d 35 (Wyo. 2011). The Mayor opened the floor for discussion, but none of Ms. Cain's supporters came forward although they had protestation/support signs. I did not stay for the licensing of haulers. That was under the new council for which it may appear that Ms. Cain has support. The haulers licensing was postponed to the next meeting January 15, 2019.

In light of this meeting, and in light of the Judge's comment at our hearing that if the council had already taken action under *Gronberg* she would dismiss the suit, I am asking you to agree to a stipulated dismissal with prejudice, each side paying their own fees and costs.

I am imposing a deadline of January 11, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. for Ms. Cain to agree to the dismissal. This deadline should not be perceived as a threat in any respect; I just do not want to spend any more money on attorney's fees and costs if it can be avoided.

In addition, I likely will not get any transcripts of the two council meetings transcribed before January 11, 2019; therefore, my motion for summary judgment will not occur until the later part of January after I receive those transcripts.
