AN ORDINANCE BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF RAWLINS, CARBON COUNTY, WYOMING, REGULATING PARKING OF MOTOR COACHES, BUSES, MOTOR HOMES, CAMPERS, FIFTH WHEEL TRAILERS, HORSE TRAILERS, ATV/SNOWMOBILE TRAILERS, FLATBED TRAILERS, BOATS, BOAT TRAILERS OR TRAILERS OF ANYTYPE ON CITY STREETS, ROADWAYS, ALLEYS OR RIGHT-OF-WAYS.

WHEREAS, Wyoming Statute 15-1-103(a) (xi) grants authority to the governing bodies of all cities and towns to take all necessary action to maintain and regulate the use of streets; and

WHEREAS, Wyoming Statute 15-1-103(a) (xli) grants authority to the governing bodies of cities and towns to adopt ordinances necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the city or town; and

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Rawlins has determined that regulation of the parking of recreational vehicles and trailers on City streets in residential areas is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the City and will be greatly beneficial to city staff during snow removal.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, Section 10.33.030 is hereby added to the City ordinances as follows:

No motor coach, bus, motor home, camper, fifth wheel trailer, horse trailer, all-terrain vehicle/snowmobile trailer, flatbed trailer, boat, boat trailer, or trailer of any type shall be parked on city streets, roadways, alleys or city rights-of-way except as necessary for the express purpose of loading or unloading for a reasonable time but in no case shall it exceed four (4) hours, beginning on Labor Day through Memorial Day to allow for the unobstructed removal of snow by city staff. Repeated practice or any attempt to circumvent the purpose of this ordinance shall be prohibited. Nothing in this section is intended to allow recreational vehicles or trailers to be parked in violation of any other sections of this chapter.
